



MALDEN'S "GOOD-NEIGHBOR" POLICY

For the health, safety and welfare of your neighbors, the City of Malden requires you to observe the following regulations:

On **TRASH REMOVAL:**

- ◆ It is illegal to dispose of waste on property other than your own.
- ◆ All trash placed for collection must be in a blue "Pay As You Throw" bag. Bags cost \$1.00 & \$2.00 each and can be purchased at local retail stores, the City Clerks Office or DPW Yard.
- ◆ Trash in barrels should not weigh more than 50 pounds and PAYT bags should not weigh more than 35 pounds.
- ◆ Place trash at your curb after 9 p.m. on the evening before collection is scheduled.
- ◆ Do not include any of the following in your trash: household appliances, construction debris, and hazardous waste, such as paint, tires or CRTs.
- ◆ Store lawn or garden waste in paper bags for collection during spring and fall.
- ◆ Take in empty barrels promptly. If your trash is not collected, you must take it back to the storage area on your property until the problem is resolved.
- ◆ Recycle when ever possible. Stickers to designate a trash barrel as a recycling barrel are available at the DPW Yard.

On **CARE OF ANIMALS:**

- ◆ Vaccinate your dogs and cats against rabies
- ◆ License your dog each year at the City Clerk's Office.
- ◆ Clean up after your pets – animal waste carries disease and is harmful to humans.
- ◆ Leash your dog when it is not on your property.
- ◆ Keep your dog out of city parks, playgrounds, school grounds and cemeteries.
- ◆ Restrain your dog from nipping or biting people or other animals.
- ◆ Do not allow your dog to disturb the neighborhood by barking.
- ◆ Do not keep exotic animals (such as pigs, chickens, monkeys, or snakes) without a permit from the Animal Control Officer.

Additionally you should:

On **CARE OF PROPERTY:**

- ♥ Shovel the snow on the sidewalk in front of your home.
- ♥ Recycle all plastics and newspapers weekly in the recycling bin provided by the City.
- ♥ Park vehicles in a driveway, rather than on the street, whenever possible.

- ◆ Keep grass, bushes and trees trimmed and pools and ponds clean. Standing water and overgrown weeds attract pests that are dangerous to humans.
- ◆ Remove all vegetation that overhangs public sidewalks.
- ◆ Do not allow trash to accumulate on your property.
- ◆ Park only registered and insured cars in your driveway or on your property.
- ◆ Obtain a permit from the Building Department before making any improvement to your home.
- ◆ Be sure that your BBQ grill is more than 5 feet away from any building and that there is nothing above it that might catch on fire.
- ◆ When shoveling your driveway or walks, do not put snow on the sidewalk or street.

- ◆ Never park commercial vehicles on the street between 9:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m.
