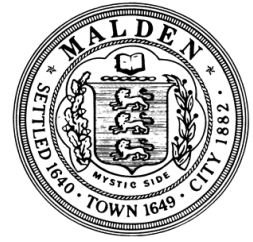

## MALDEN CITY COUNCIL NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

*In accordance with the requirements of Chapter 166 of the General Laws, you are hereby notified that the Malden City Council will hold a virtual public hearing at 7:00 P.M. on Tuesday, February 16, 2021 on a petition from Massachusetts Electric d/b/a National Grid of North Andover, Massachusetts:*

- **Fairlawn and Main Street**

Petitions and plans are available for public review in the City Clerk's Office, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, 215 Pleasant Street, Malden, MA **(BY APPOINTMENT ONLY)**.

Massachusetts Electric Company d/b/a National Grid of North Andover, Massachusetts, *that it desires to construct a line of underground electric conduits, including the necessary sustaining and protecting fixtures, under and across the public way or ways hereinafter named.*

- Plan # 29146213 Fairlawn Street – permission to excavate the public highways and to run and maintain underground electric conduits, together with such sustaining and protecting fixtures as it may find necessary for the transmission of electricity, said underground conduits to be located substantially in accordance with the plan herewith marked: Fairlawn St. – Malden – Massachusetts.

The following are the streets and highways referred to:

Plan # 29146213 Fairlawn St – National Grid to install beginning at a point approximately 40 feet west of the centerline of the intersection of Main St. and Fairlawn St. and continuing approximately 6060 feet in a west direction. Install 1 new manhole, 606' of conduit, and trenching west from the intersection of Fairlawn St. and Main St.

*In accordance with Governor Baker's March 12, 2020 Order Suspending Certain Provisions of the Open Meeting Law, G.L. c. 30A, §18, and Governor' Baker's March 23, 2020 Revised Guidance on Order by the Governor Prohibiting Assemblage of More than Ten People, this hearing will be virtual and conducted via remote participation to the greatest extent possible. No in- person attendance by members of the public will be permitted, and all effort will be made to permit remote public attendance and participation in this virtual hearing via technological means, in the manner specified below, and if available, via public broadcast of the meeting by Malden Access Cable Television on public access television channels.*
