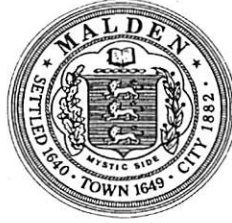

The next item on the agenda is the application of Idle Hands, 89 Commercial Street for a one-day special license for their annual Oktoberfest to be held on September 10, 2022, from 12 noon through 10 pm.

Chairman Kinnon recognized Chris Tkach of Idle Hands to speak about the event. Chris said they will have a tent area in the parking lot which will be fenced off. They will have food vendors along with live music. This will be their 5th year having this event and they have never had any problems. Last year they raised \$2,000 for charity. They hope to reach that mark again this year.

Chairman Kinnon noted that they have been doing this event for years with no issues. He asks that Chris work with MFD and MPD to make sure they are satisfied. He also asks that the Building Inspector be notified for inspection of the tent.
