TWO-WEEK LOOK-AHEAD

January 2 to 15, 2020

- The next major phase in the project will be to remove the “oval” in the middle of the intersection. The first step is to extract the utility pole
- National Grid will be the first utility company to move its electric service cables from the old pole to the new one, and they have committed to doing so by January 17.
- After electric service moved, the telecommunications companies will do the same.

(Note: In the winter months, all construction work depends on favorable weather conditions.)

Crews will remove “oval” in the middle of the intersection after the utility companies move their cables off the pole.



The new pole is to the left in this photo and is off to the side of what will be the new intersection. The old pole is to the right, seen here with all utilities still attached, is in the middle of the “oval.”
